**Indigo Dye**; Learn several ways to fold, clamp, tie and stitch fabric to create a unique item in beautiful, permanent indigo blue, a natural plant-based dye. You can also bring your own wearable items. **They must be 100% cotton, silk, or rayon.** Mixed fibers like 50/50 poly-cotton will NOT accept the die. Pre-wash your items to remove starchy sizing added at the factory. Limit 10 students.



**Chicken Scratch Embroidery Heart.** Simple variations on cross stitch from a time when lace was just too expensive for the average family. Limit 10 students.



**Needle Felted Animals or Tulips** If you can stick a pin in a pincushion you can needle felt. We will guide you through creating a colorful wool picture suitable for framing. Limit 10 students.



**Fun With Watercolor: Abstract Flowers** Let gravity help you create these fun, easy floral designs. Paint four small compositions then frame your favorite. Limit 10 students.
